### PROTECTING DEMOCRACY AND WORKERS RIGHT TO A VOICE AT WORK

1. The Texas AFL-CIO and all unions will communicate with their members regarding the threat to the union rights of 700,000 Department of Defense and Department of Homeland Security employees, and ask them to help fight this attack by calling upon the members of Congress to pass legislation to protect America from these destructive actions.
2. The Texas AFL-CIO and the member unions will request that the AFL-CIO and all national unions immediately work in Solidarity to lobby and provide other support to secure Congressional legislation to restore the rights of these American citizens who serve with patriotism and courage to defend the rights and freedoms for all Americans.

### POSTAL REFORM

1. The Texas AFL-CIO and its members go on record as supporting HR 22 and S662 and that every affiliate union and members be urged to coordinate with the NALC on these issues.
